 (church; conversion; disciple)
- Galatian 4:19 Paul wrote these words, "I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you." How do we make disciples?



 We need every member to be a disciple, and every disciple to be a disciple maker if we are going to make a push toward zero. This morning let's talk about two key tools of transformation. These tools are critical for every disciple maker. (Greek word – metamorphoo)

- The first key transformational tool for disciple makers is truth. Romans 12:2, "Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." Truth is a transformational tool in people's lives.
- Church is a good first step because it exposes people to the truth. (CD's)



- The first key transformational tool for disciple makers is truth. Romans 12:2
- We also need to help people appropriate the truth in practical ways in their life. We can begin discipling someone before they come to faith in Christ. (e.g., broken relationships, anger & Luke 6:27-28) (e.g., anxiety; 1 John 4:18 & Phil 4:4-7)

- The first key transformational tool for disciple makers is truth. Romans 12:2
- The teacher who is eager to help others, and knows that he doesn't have all the answers, has the potential of being the greatest student of all. Pass on what you are learning.

 The second key transformational tool for disciple makers is the presence of God. 2 Cor 3:17-18, "Now the Lord is Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is Spirit."

- The second key transformational tool for disciple makers is the presence of God. 2 Cor 3:17-18
- The presence of God is transformational. We need to do all we can to help connect people to God's presence (Church Christmas service; Prayer Jonathan; Prophetic words manifest presence encouraging, 1
 Corinthians 14:24-25) Time with God
